



## 2017 Membership Mailing Letter

Membership rates have not changed for the 2017 season. The Single rate will be \$50.00 and the Family rate will be \$60.00. A Family Membership includes only children under 18. Children over 18 will require their own Single Membership. Both parents, in a Family Membership, must sign waivers and attend (or have attended) the Range Orientation.

All current renewing members will receive 5 tickets for the "Members Only" raffle. We will be raffling off 3 Ruger 10/22 rifles, with a 525 pack of .22LR ammo included with each rifle, on February 13<sup>th</sup> at 7pm. After the gun raffle is conducted the KSC membership committee will begin vetting new membership applications for the 2017 year. All additional money raised from the raffle will be used to offset fixed operating expenses that continue to rise every year.

Please remember that KSC Membership cards are to be in the possession of the member while on the Range at all times. THEY ARE NOT TO BE LOANED OR GIVEN TO ANYONE FOR ANY REASON TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE RANGE. Family member guests are welcome at the range as long as they are under direct supervision by the KSC member card holder WHO IS ALSO AT THE RANGE WITH THEM!

Again, for the 2017 year, all renewals are expected to be submitted no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> 2016. Any renewals received after that date will incur a \$10.00 late fee on top of the \$50/\$60 membership renewal fee. Late renewals will only be accepted up to February 15<sup>th</sup> 2017. KSC Members not renewed by then will be viewed as having abandoned their membership with the KSC. Any individuals or family members who wish to renew after the February 13<sup>th</sup> renewal drop dead date will need to appeal their case to the KSC board officers for reinstatement.

### **No cash will be accepted for memberships. Check or Money Orders only.**

Recent problems at the Range have included people shooting the Steel Handgun plates at 7yd 12yd and 21yd with high power rifles and ruining the targets, as well as people shooting at the 100yd gong with AP rounds and punching holes thru the plate. These are all violations of the Range Rules.

Range Hours are to be strictly observed by all members!!!! Any member shooting outside of the designated seasonal adjusted range hours will be expelled from the club by the KSC Board of directors.
